Revitalization: Collective Action for the Ocean

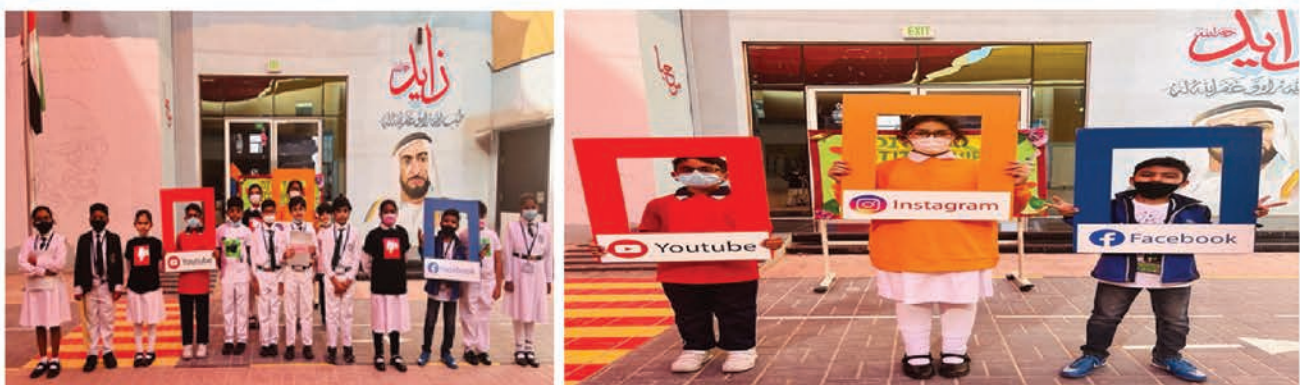

Blood Donor's Day

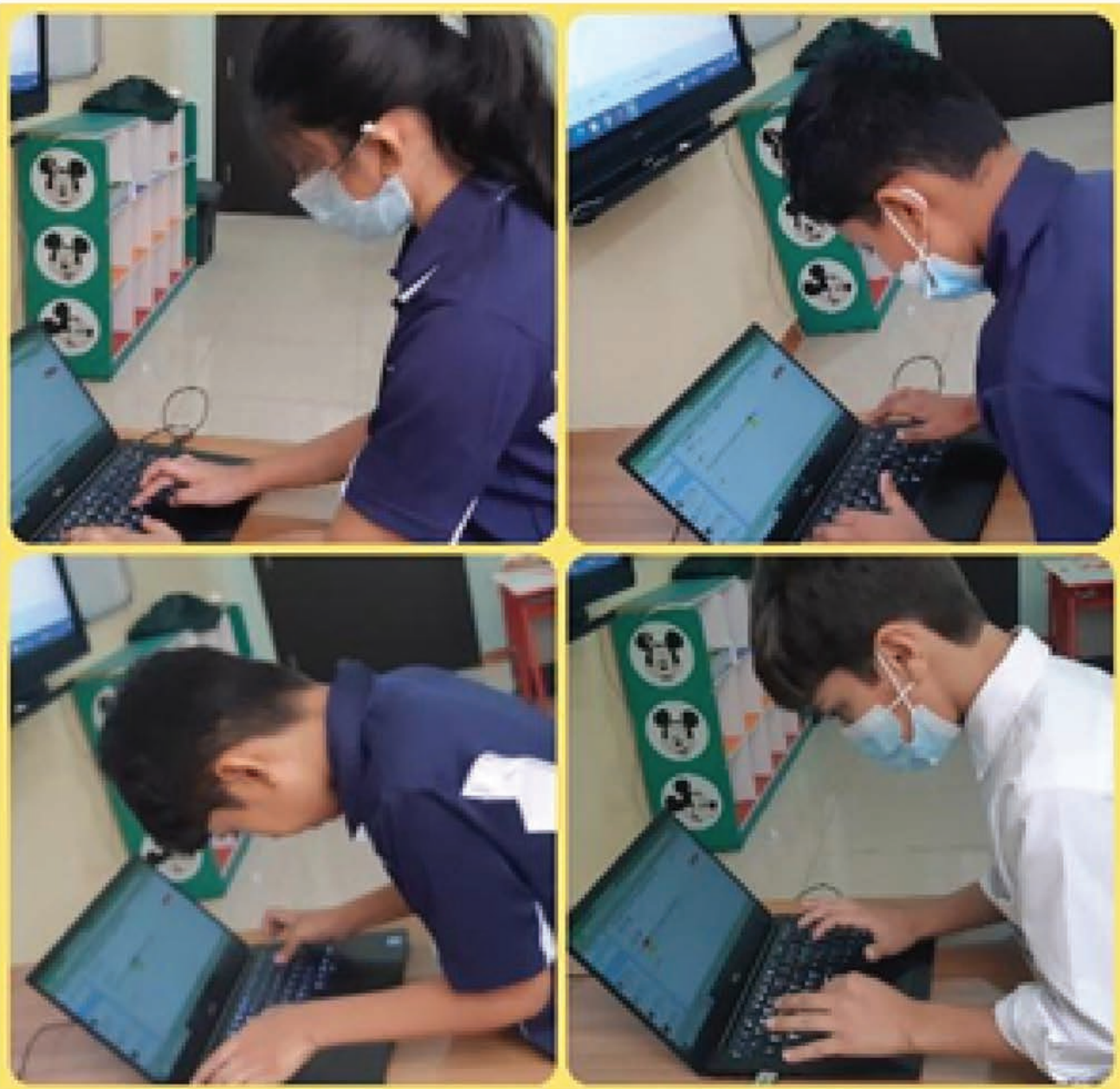
