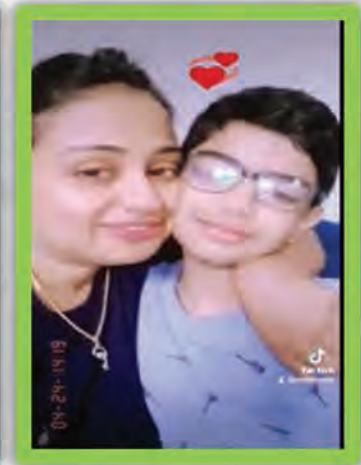
Pink Colour Day

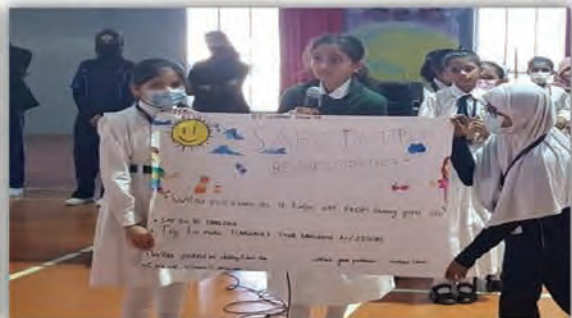
The students from grade 7-12 also attended an online webinar conducted by RISA, on the topic 'Tobacco A Threat to Human Life and Environment'.





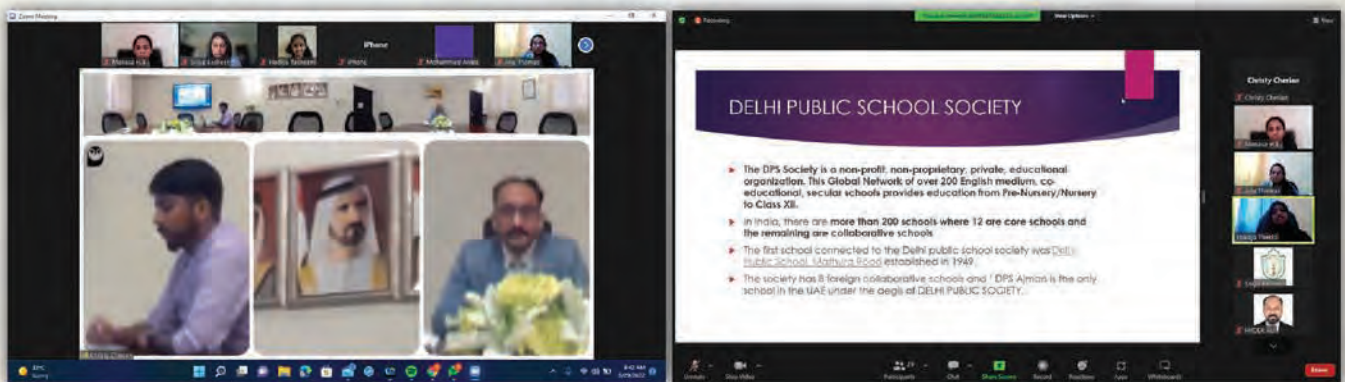
Let's beat the summer

A Grave Demise of the Nation

He was known for his reforms and development projects in the UAE. Under H H Khalifa's leadership, the UAE underwent a period of significant reform and development. One of his most notable achievements was the introduction of the Abu Dhabi Defence Force, which after 1971 became the core of the UAE Armed Forces. As his father worked towards the unity of the nation, which would come into being on December 2, 1971, Sheikh H H Khalifa was given more responsibility as Prime Minister of Abu Dhabi, while also being called to serve as the Emirate's Defence and Finance Minister.

Though it is a great loss for the country, the UAE has a strong government that is capable of handling this transition. Additionally, H H Sheikh Khalifa's half-brother, H H Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, is now the president of Abu Dhabi and is widely seen as a capable leader who can take the country to the path of glory and honour. As such, it is likely that the UAE will continue to be a stable country even without the late H.H Sheikh Khalifa.

The death of His Highness is a great loss to the people of the United Arab Emirates. He was a strong leader who guided the country through its development into a modern, prosperous nation. His wisdom and guidance will be missed by all who had the privilege to know him.
