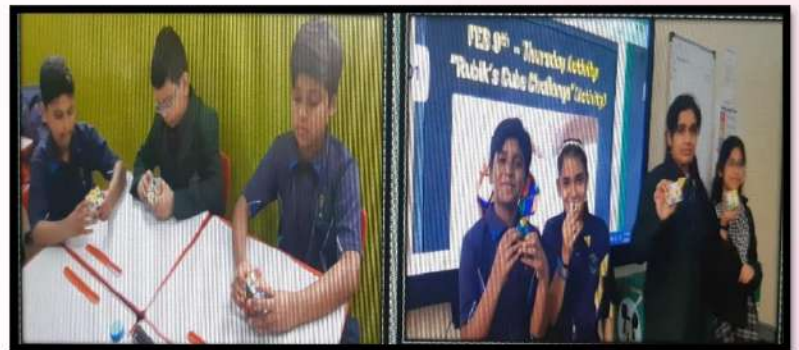
Ad Mad
