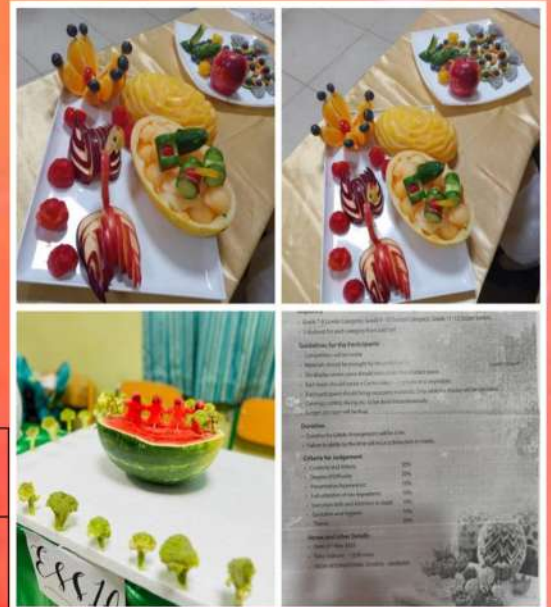


Aiming for the excellence, reaching for the stars:
